

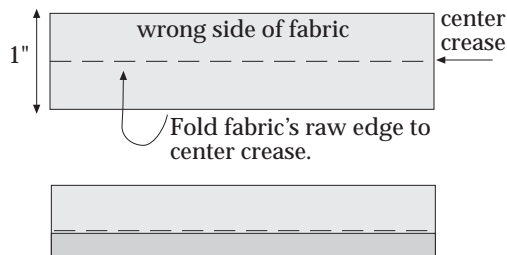
# Bias Cord for Vines & Other Decorations

To make a 1/4" - wide (finished) cord:

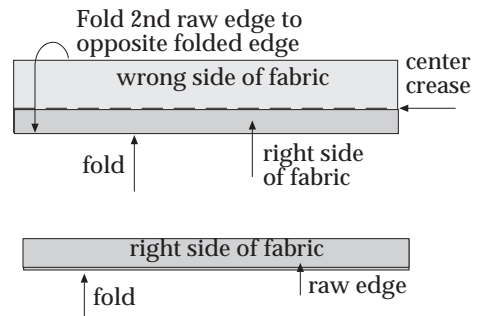
1. Press the fabric to be used for your bias cord. Then lightly spray-starch this fabric. Next cut 1" bias strips from your fabric using a 45-degree angle. Cut as many strips as needed for the length of cord required for your project.

2. Fold and press the strip in half lengthwise, right sides out; unfold.

3. Carefully fold and press one long raw edge to the center fold, right sides out.



4. Press the remaining long raw edge almost to the opposite (folded) edge of the strip, making a 1/4" - wide finished strip. The raw edge from the second fold should be completely covered by the folded strip. If not, trim the visible raw edge carefully.



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
