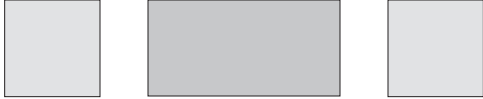
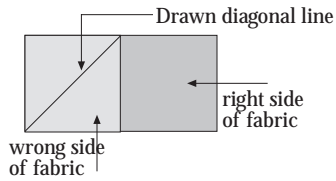


Flying Geese Units

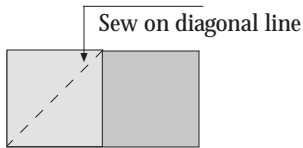
1. For each unit, cut two squares and one rectangle in the size stated in your pattern instructions.



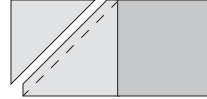
2. Draw a line from one corner to its diagonal opposite on the squares, using a pencil or chalk. Place the first square on one side of the rectangle, right sides together. Pin in place.



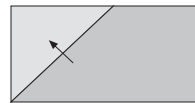
3. Sew directly on the drawn diagonal line through both layers.



4. Draw a seam allowance line 1/4" from the seam line. Cut directly on this line to trim off the excess fabric.



5. Press the stitching line (set the seam). Then open up the sewn triangular shape, as shown.



6. Repeat the earlier steps to sew the second side of the flying-geese unit. Place the drawn square on the right side of the rectangle. Pin the shapes together. Again, sew directly on the drawn line. Trim excess fabric. Set the seam. Press open the triangular shape to complete the unit.
